

TRIUNE PRAISE DEVOTIONAL

This song attempts to express praise concerning the glorious reality of the Triune nature of God, commonly known as the doctrine of the trinity. God has revealed Himself in the Scriptures as one. The Christian faith is monotheistic. However, God has also revealed Himself in the Scriptures as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The distinction within God and the unity of God are both simultaneously true. This is very mysterious. It is incomprehensible.


Nevertheless, even as our minds are blown by this reality, we are called to worship God for who He has revealed Himself to be. James White, in his book "The Forgotten Trinity" gave a particularly helpful explanation of this teaching. In defining the orthodox understanding of the trinity, he said:

"Within the one Being that is God, there eternally exists three coequal and co-eternal Persons, namely God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit." (James White, The Forgotten Trinity)

Each of the phrases in this definition is important. God is one Being, not three beings. Each of the Persons are fully God. And each Person exists eternally. Even as there is equality among the Persons of the trinity, the Scriptures also teach that there is diversity in their particular roles. The Father sent the Son to pay for the sins of His people. It was the Son who died on the cross, not the Father. The Holy Spirit was sent by the Father and the Son and not the other way around, etc. These truths have a great deal of significance for how we live our lives as Christians and how we relate to those around us.

Triune Praise is a song of praise to God that seeks to ascribe glory to God for His tri-unity. Each verse is addressed to a different Person in the trinity. We would encourage you to prayerfully read through the song with an open Bible as you check the Scripture references. May God stir up a sense of awe and wonder in your heart as you worship Him for who He is. And may it affect the way that you pray, as well as the lens through which you understand the Scriptures, relationships and life itself.





Questions for Reflection:

- 1. How often do you meditate on each Person of the Trinity individually?
- 2. Does your prayer and worship reflect the reality that God is Triune?
- 3. In what practical ways does the doctrine of the trinity play itself in your life?

And it's only by You that we cry out "Abba Father" (Gal. 4:6) You're the Spirit of adoption, the Spirit of Truth, (Romans 8:15, John 14:16-17)
