friends to put together a group that seemed too good to be true. A pure love for playing marked that period in George Harrison's musical life. The Wilburys would go on to earn a Grammy and are still remembered as the "supergroup" like no other. Following their first release, *Volume One*, and the loss of Roy Orbison, the band recorded a second full-length gem, *Volume Three*, title provided by George.

Throughout the last decade of his life, George Harrison wrote as he traveled the world. Always intending to make another album, he accumulated a stockpile of demos. But, in 2001, after a life of artistic and spiritual adventures, George Harrison passed away. Many of the songs on *Brainwashed*, his final recording, were finished posthumously by Jeff Lynne and Dhani Harrison. They called on several among the friends who regularly accompanied George in the studio. As a collection of songs it is both reserved and exhilarating. "Rising Sun"
